CSRC TRUSTEE VACANCIES

Due to the retirement of some long serving members of the Trustees Board, Clwyd Special Riding Centre is looking for three new Trustees.

Clwyd Special Riding Centre (CSRC) is a very successful local charity based in Llanfynydd. CSRC offers a variety of equine experiences for people with additional needs. Set in over 30 acres with 26 horses of all sizes and types, supported by a team of 11 staff, 12 Trustees and over 130 volunteers. The aim of CSRC is to provide a beneficial experience to all persons through riding, carriage driving, equestrian vaulting, equine learning and therapy and hippotherapy.

CSRC has been running for nearly forty years and over the past four years has developed considerably. Each week 150 people visit CSRC to experience riding, carriage driving, equestrian vaulting, equine learning, equine therapy and hippotherapy. Holidays are also offered with purpose built accommodation. Clwyd Special Riding Centre is unique and the only one of its kind in the UK.

THE ROLE

The role of a Trustee can be a rewarding one and gives you the opportunity to bring your skills, talents and knowledge to make a real contribution to the charity and its beneficiaries.

Our Trustees play a very important role in making sure that the charity is run in the interests of the people it is here to support. They strategically oversee the management and administration of the organisation.

We are looking for people experienced in one or more of the following areas but would consider other areas of expertise:

- Fundraising
- HR knowledge
- Land/estate management

Our Trustees meet during the day on every third Wednesday of each month at CSRC. Each member also sits on at least one of six sub-committees: Finance, Fundraising, Equine, Staffing, Maintenance and the CSRC RDA Group. These sub-committees meet every six to eight weeks. **No remuneration is offered for performing the duties of a Trustee at Clwyd Special Riding Centre.**
